When interviewed by Manko Mangena on the 25th of June 2011 at Sekororo Tribal Authority, Mamokaile Mahlo provided information on the Royal Clan of Banareng Ba Sekororo who migrated from Serowe in Botswana. Their first leader was Kgoshi Tloropsane in 1600. They arrived at Ga Sekororo in around 1818 and since then there had been nine leaders in succession. The current (on 25th of June 2011) leader is Sekgalabjana Sekororo Seshego Solomon Mahlo. The past leaders lived in many places before they could settle at Ga Sekororo, they moved from place to place because of wars. References:1.
